Thank you for your correspondence to the Premier and the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure about the CBD and South East Light Rail (CSELR) project. The Minister has asked me to respond on his behalf.

I note your ongoing interest in the CSELR project and that you have contacted the Minister's Office on multiple occasions to discuss this matter.

As you are aware, prior to the commencement of construction of the CSELR, many transport solutions for the CBD and South East Sydney were considered, including electric buses. Ultimately, light rail was found to be the best transport solution. The NSW Government is committed to delivering light rail in the CBD and South East Sydney, Western Sydney and Newcastle.

I believe that the issues you have raised have been thoroughly canvassed. Any future correspondence from you on the CSELR will be noted and filed without acknowledgement.

While I appreciate you may be disappointed with this outcome, I believe it would be an unreasonable use of public resources to continue to respond on these issues, where the position of the NSW Government remains unchanged.
