I refer to your further correspondence to the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure about your proposal for electric buses as part of Sydney's transport future and as an alternative to the CBD and South East Light Rail project. I have been asked to respond once more to you.

I note your request for a course of action to submit your proposal on electric buses to the NSW Government for consideration.

I note you have raised your concerns and your proposal to the Minister on a number of occasions. This has included several items of email and phone calls. You have been provided responses that clearly articulate the NSW Government's position, which is to deliver light rail in the CBD and South East Sydney, Western Sydney and Newcastle.
